Thespy & Tech Challenge Registration in Open Water

1. Click on the link or button on the Thespy page: [Thespys - Indiana Thespians](#) or the Tech Challenge page: [Tech Challenge - Indiana Thespians](#)
2. Log in to your EdTA account
3. Fill out Troupe Director information - first and last name, email address
4. Fill out school name, troupe number, and choose grade level
5. Choose the category the student is participating in and fill out the relevant information.
  - a. Title of Piece is required for all entries. For Tech Challenge, enter a team name as title. For Films or Playwriting that may not yet have a title, TBD is acceptable.
  - b. Choose the appropriate option from the next list. If entering a Tech Challenge team, choose public domain and put in **n/a** for the required fields that pop up.
  - c. For all performance entries - Check the publisher list! If you enter a piece that is not on the acceptable list and not approved by EdTA, you will still pay for the entry, but it will not be allowed and the student will not perform. I don't want students to miss out on performing! PLEASE CHECK THE LIST!

6. **Participant Information:** Click the Add Participants button to add students to the entry. After typing a name, click add, then repeat for each participant.
7. Check any applicable activities.
8. For all performance pieces - including film and playwriting - rate the appropriateness of the entry. Please read the description of each rating carefully and choose accordingly.
  - a. If you are registering a non-performance entry, choose level 1.
9. Click Save if you need to gather more information and return to the application at a later time. Click Save and Finalize if you are done. You will be charged \$10 per participant in each entry that is finalized. An invoice will be sent to you after registration closes.
10. If you are entering a short film or a playwriting script, you will be able to check out and then open the SAME entry later to upload the film or script by the Jan 9th deadline. You will receive an email with instructions on this AFTER the December deadline if you have entries in these categories.
